36th District Agricultural Association Dixon May Fair Ticket Policy

PURPOSE STATEMENT

The annual Dixon May Fair, through agricultural, educational, entertainment and recreational opportunities to the general public, promotes and showcases the diverse talents, interests, accomplishments and agricultural heritage of the residents of California, especially the youth of Solano County.

- 1) It is the intent of the Dixon May Fair Credential Policy to distribute credentials for the annual fair, produced by the 36th District Agricultural Association, that serve the Dixon May Fair's purpose, allow recipients to perform their official duties and functions while at the fair and serve a public purpose. Official duties include but are not limited to: attendance at the annual fair to evaluate attractions, carnival, entertainment, exhibits, programs, shows and vendors for the betterment of the Association and the people it serves.
- 2) Credential and Courtesy admission credentials (as defined by sections 3002 & 3003 of the CA Food & Agriculture Code) will be distributed in accordance with the State of California Food and Agricultural Codes section 3022 3029 which states the following:

CALIFORNIA CODES

FOOD AND AGRICULTURAL CODE

SECTION 3022-3027

3022. If a charge is made for admission to enter a state, district, county, or citrus fruit fair, the following persons may be admitted to such fairgrounds without the payment of the established admission price:

(a) Persons with credential admissions.

Definition of Credential Admission as defined by Food & Agricultural code section 3003. "Credential admission" means any admission which is authorized by the board of directors of a state, district, or citrus fruit fair, or by the board of supervisors of a county for admission to a fair without payment of the admission charge when a service is rendered by the person who is admitted which is necessary for the conduct of the fair.

(b) Persons with courtesy pass admissions.

Definition of Courtesy Pass Admission as defined by Food & Agricultural code section 3002. "Courtesy pass admission" means any admission, without payment of the admission charge, to any state, county, district, or citrus fruit fair, except any of the following:

(a) Credential admission. (b) Admission of any child under 12 years of age. (Dixon May Fair policy is free admission for children 4 and under, discounted admission for 5 to 12 years old. Kids Day annually on Friday of the Fair admits all Children 12 and under into the fair for free.)

(c) Admission of any military personnel in uniform.

- **3023**. A credential admission may be issued to any individual, association, or body that does any of the following:
- (a) Prepares or services any educational, commercial, industrial, livestock, **agricultural**, horticultural, or viticultural display or exhibit.

(b) Services, maintains, or operates any concession.

- (c) Renders, through agreement with the fair, a service to fair patrons.
- (d) Renders a necessary public service.
- (e) Safeguards health.
- (f) Provides for public safety.
- (g) Participates in any parade or event, which is necessary for the conduct of the fair.

3024. Credential admissions may, also, be issued to any of the following persons:

- (a) Representatives of press, radio, and television personally engaged in obtaining and transmitting public information.
 - (b) Ambulance drivers.
 - (c) Firemen on duty.

- (d) Repairmen who are necessary to service utilities.
- (e) Employees of the fair.
- (f) State officials in the performance of their duty.
- **3025**. The words "credential admission" shall be printed on each ticket, which is issued as a credential admission.
- **3026**. The percentage of courtesy pass admissions to any state, county, district, or citrus fruit fair shall not exceed 4 percent of the gross paid admission to the fair in the preceding calendar year. **3027**. A courtesy pass admission is not transferable.

In accordance with section 3024 of the CA Food and Agriculture Code credentials are issued to the Fair Board of Directors so they can perform their duties during the annual fair which is a four-day event in May. Courtesy Admission credentials may be issued to directors, per CA Food & Agriculture Code 4403 allowing promotional and public relations purposes, in order to assist in promoting the fair and in accordance with their duties to assist management with raising money for the Association.
